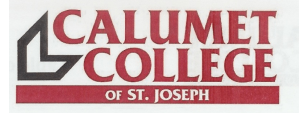

The show closes at 8 p.m. and reopens at 9 a.m. Saturday with the student competition held at 1 p.m.. It concludes at 5 p.m.

The Show features artists **who use recycled products or who focus on nature and the environment**. Feel free to recommend colleagues who fit this category. As in the past, AWLI asks a 10 percent commission on all works sold during the exhibit. AWLI also will mail advance notices to your clientele if requested.
